



Vita Gesualdo Coggi

Gesualdo Coggi, born in Frosinone, Italy in 1985, began his musical studies at the age of five under the supervision of his grandfather, the composer Gesualdo Coggi. He was awarded with the Third Prize of the 57th International Piano Competition "Ferruccio Busoni" 2009.

He studied with Fausto Di Cesare and Roberto Cappello; in 2002 he graduated with honours in Piano at "Santa Cecilia" Conservatory of Rome, and in 2010 he got the Master Degree with honours at "A. Boito" Conservatory of Parma. He followed also Eliso Virsaladze's improvers courses at the Scuola di Musica di Fiesole and the Master Course in Music Studies of Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia under the guidance of Benedetto Lupo.

He attended several masterclasses with pianists such as Alfred Brendel, François-Joel Thiollier, Valery Piasetsky, Franco Scala, Aquiles Delle Vigne, Choong Mo Kang.



Gesualdo Coggi has performed in several important Italian and foreign venues including Conciliazione Auditorium and Sapienza University's Great Hall - Rome, RAI Auditorium - Turin, Teatro Regio - Parma, Steinway Hall - London, Loyola University - Chicago, De Doelen Theatre - Rotterdam, Halls of Italian Culture Institutes of Hamburg, New York, Marseille, Budapest, in recital and as soloist with orchestras such as Rome Symphonic Orchestra, Rome Sinfonietta Orchestra, Bolzano Haydn Orchestra, Budapest Symphony Orchestra MAV, Toscanini Symphony Orchestra (Parma), Kaluga Symphony Orchestra.

He usually performs with the flutist Paolo Taballione and RAI Italian National Symphonic Orchestra Lead Parts.

He recorded G. Martucci's Two Piano Concertos for the Naxos Record Label.

Currently he is Piano Professor at "A. Boito" Conservatory of Parma (Italy).
