

1. Preis Professionals: Uliana Zhivitskaya

Uliana Zhivitskaya was born in Ekaterinburg, she has been living in Moscow since 2009.

When she was a student of the Special Gnessin School of Music, young girl became a laureate of many international competitions, such as: the International Competition “The Nutcracker” in 2012, the Adams Flute Factor in the Netherlands. At the International Radio Competition “Concertino Praga” she was awarded the 1st Prize, the Helena Karaskova Prize, and the EMCY Prize, the Best Performance of Obligatory Composition Prize.

Uliana participated in many concerts of Vladimir Spivakov Foundation. She played in many countries and performed in the best halls in Moscow. Also, Uliana collaborates with many renowned ensembles: “Pratum Integrum”, “Musica Tempora”, “Collegium Musicum”, “Rosarium”.

During the Moscow Conservatory years, Uliana successfully performed at the W. Neese competition (1st Prize), the Kuhlau competition (2nd Prize and the Soroptimist Prize).
